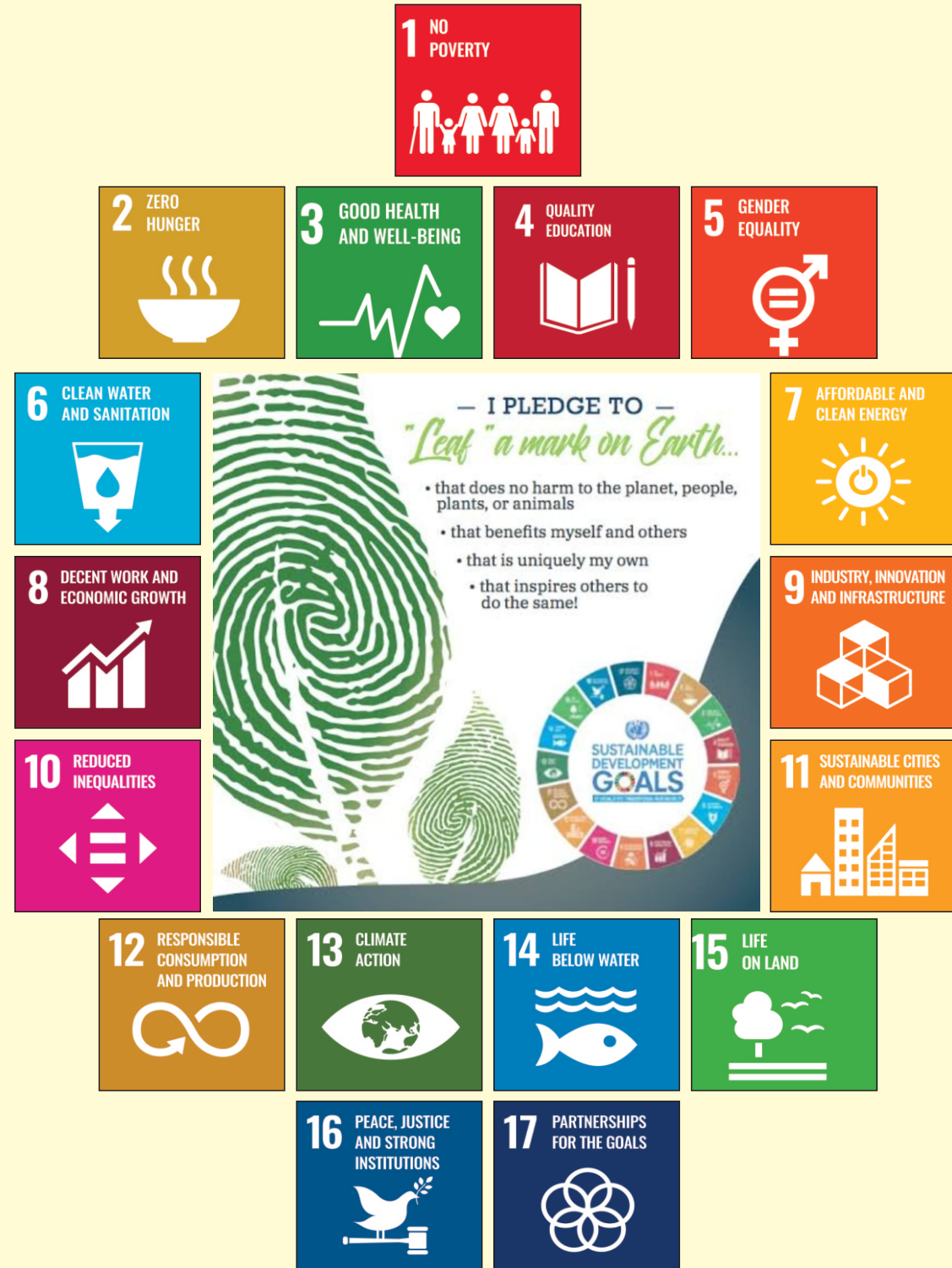

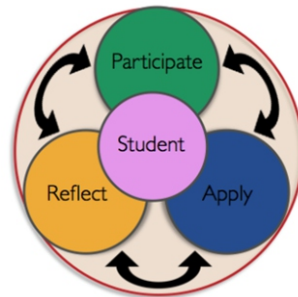


# I CAN LEARN

An institute of purposeful learning that focuses on the whole child; body, mind, and spirit



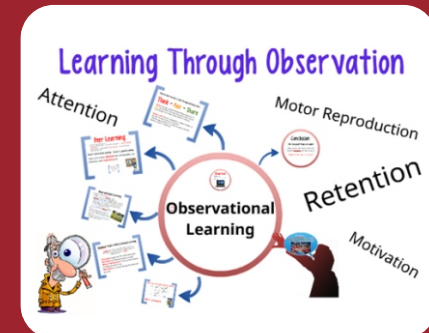

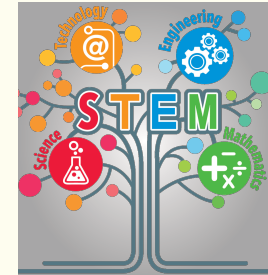
## Nature Club (ECO Warriors)

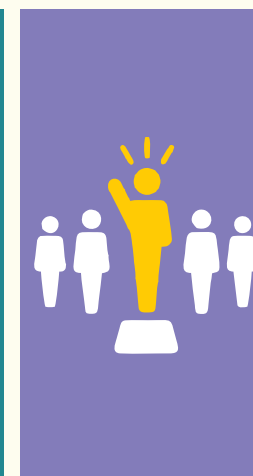


## Organizational & Leadership Club

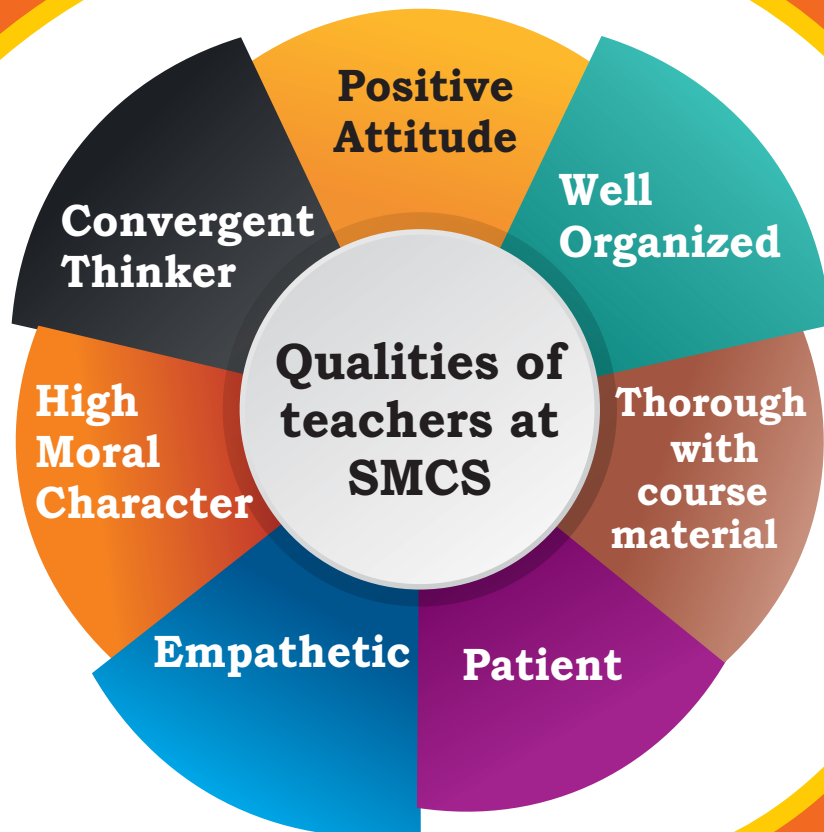
A student can choose to gain competency based skill learning along with general education in order to enhance the skills in the chosen field. These courses allow students to explore new avenues available.

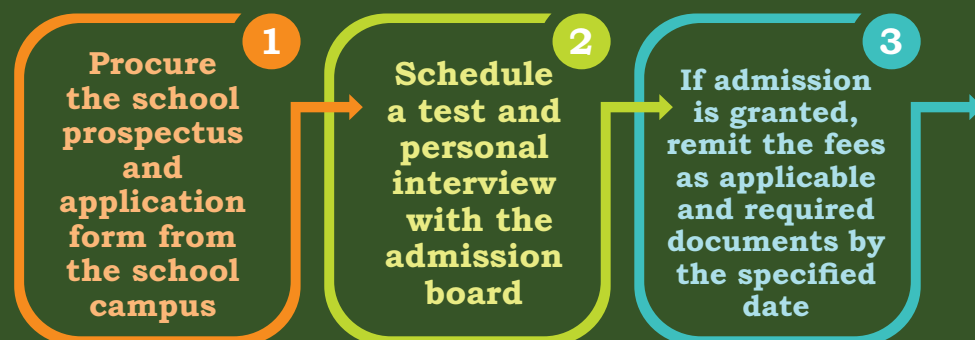

# ADMISSION TO ST. MARY'S CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

## Admission Process



- \* The management reserves to itself the right of admission to any prospective pupil.
- \* Allotment to higher or lower classes will be done according to the CBSE criteria.
- \* Admission is finalized after a preliminary "Application Skills Assessment" of the child and payment of the prescribed processing fee which, once paid, is not refundable under any circumstances.
- \* The caution money is however refundable on withdrawal of a child after giving due notice or on completion of studies in the school. The original admission receipt is to be compulsorily presented for the same.

**Under the Directives of U.P govt. there is an annual increase in all heads of the school fee (Approximately 10%)**

## School Visit

A visit to SMCS is best understood as a chance for visitors and their families to see the school in action and to introduce themselves. ## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- \* Admission form filled by parents or the lawful guardian
- \* 2 photographs each of the child as well as parents
- \* Aadhar Card copies of both parents & child.
- \* Municipal Birth Certificate
- \* Immunization Record
- \* Blood Group Certificate
- \* Medical Record (if a child is under treatment due to any chronic illness) Details of any specific allergens
- \* Evidence of having graduated from the previous class
- \* Transfer Certificate (countersigned by the Education officer of the District concerned)
- \* Proof of residence
- \* Caste Certificate (If OB, SC & ST)
- \* Admission to Grade IX & XI are strictly subjected to approval by CBSE

## ADMISSION TO CLASS XI

- ❖ Whilst admitting students to class XI, the school will make a serious effort to advise students to take up stream subjects suitable for them in the school with personal counseling, aptitude tests etc. which are compulsory to all students.
- ❖ The admission, however will be barred to those students who, for serious reasons of breach of discipline or immoral conduct / negligence of study are a threat to general well being of other students
- ❖ Provisional admissions to class XI are granted to students who would have taken class X Board exam.
- ❖ After provisional stream allotment classes are started before the results are declared. Provisional stream allotment class XI is entirely at the discretion of the Admission Committee which is headed by the School Principal. Final allotment of subject stream shall take place after the Board Results. Parents desiring Marians to continue at **SMCS** are required to apply in the prescribed form. Parents, who do not complete the Admission formalities within the prescribed time ( after the Board Results are declared) will forfeit their chance of claiming seats in class XI.

**Note : Admission to class IX to XII are strictly governed by CBSE guidelines.**

## SCHOOL CONVEYANCE



- ❖ Parents wanting to avail the School bus facility should give an application at the time of Admission itself.
- ❖ The school bus / conveyance fee is charged for full 12 months of the session.
- ❖ Discontinuation of the bus facility is not allowed during the Session.
- ❖ School bus / conveyance fee can be increased as per the corresponding hike in the fuel prices (if any).
- ❖ School conveyance can be withdrawn on grounds of grave indiscipline.



# ASSESSMENT POLICY
